The property for the tiny homes has been surveyed and is making progress.

Fairmont Cove deck project will hopefully be completed by the end of May. The railings will need to be addressed next for this property.

Kneeland Parks inspection went well. There were a few small problems, but we have the funds to take care of them. There will be an inspection at the Coves this month as well.

Cascade Management has returned \$600 of the \$8,500 that is owed to the Housing Authority. The original debt was \$13,500. Next month they plan on a \$900 payment and then the continued
