

SWAC Summary

March 13, 2008

The **transfer station** in Shelton is in need of repair. The tipping floor is wearing through to the base layer, and another portion of asphalt was accidentally peeled from the concrete. Repairs will run from 6-9 thousand dollars (est.), and are hoped to be completed this month. The repair work should not significantly impact operations, but will likely cause some delays during the two day project.

The status of the **blueboxes** in Allyn was brought up. There is a temporary agreement through the end of 2008, unless a new site can be found sooner. A site near the former Taylor Town location is still being pursued. There is a County property a few miles down Lynch Road. It would need to be cleared, graded and fenced, and may need lights. The costs for this will be estimated and the expense will be considered for the 2009 operation budget.

There was a brief update of the **curbside recycling program in Shelton**. SWAC requested a copy of the article in the *Closed Loop Scoop*, an Ecology newsletter.

The **SWAC letter** has been drafted. The committee felt the letter is ready for the signature of the chair, so this will be visited in April.

Spring Clean Up will run the entire month of April. The news release will be on the 18th of March with the details.
