- 1. Call to Order The Chairperson called the regular meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance Susan Sergojan led the flag salute.
- 3. Roll Call Present: Commissioner District 2 Tim Sheldon; Commissioner District 3 Steve Bloomfield. Absent: Commissioner District 1 Lynda Ring Erickson
- 4. Correspondence and Organizational Business
 - 4.1 Correspondence
 - 4.1.1 The Washington State Liquor Control Board sent notice of assumption for Jimmy D's Waffle and Steak House, Kamilche Trading Post and Olympic Bakery, notice of added privilege for Twin Totems Deli & Grocery, notice of a special occasion liquor license application for Squaxin Island Museum, and notice of establishments with liquor licenses due to expire on August 31, 2012.
 - 4.1.2 The Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission provided their proposal to declare a portion of Harstine Island State Park as no longer advantageous for park purposes.
 - 4.1.3 The Washington State Department of Natural Resources is applying for a grant through the Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program for land acquisition at Kennedy Creek Natural Area Preserve.
 - 4.1.4 The Washington State Department of Natural Resources announced that Mason County would be one of the beneficiaries of surplus trust land management funds.
 - 4.1.5 The Mason Conservation District Board of Supervisors requested to convene the Joint Board as described in the Interlocal Agreement established between the District and the County.
 - 4.1.6 The Mason County Association of Realtors asked the Board to reconsider the make up of the Belfair Urban Growth Area Advisory Committee.
 - 4.1.7 The League of Women Voters and Ken VanBuskirk thanked the Board for providing Open Public Meetings Act training for County advisory group members.

The Ridge Motorsports' website already connects people with different facilities and businesses in the community. He wanted to see the money spent on Mason County tourism promotion in general.


