- 4. Correspondence and Organizational Business
 - 4.1 Correspondence
 - 4.1.1 The Washington State Liquor Control Board sent notice of a special occasion liquor license application for Colony Surf Club.
 - 4.1.2 Joan Olsen and Wayne Olson voiced objections to the Squaxin Island Tribe's application for acquisition of property on Arcadia Point.
 - 4.1.3 Kevin Frankeberger is seeking appointment to the Board of Equalization.
 - 4.2 Public Works Staff Recognition. Brian Matthews recognized Matt Stull for his excellent work in the GIS department. Cmmr. Neatherlin presented Mr. Stull with the Green Star Award.
