You're invited to review and comment on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the Belfair Urban Growth Area. The formal comment period will start at least 15 days prior to the May 17th public hearing (see below) and run for 30 days.





Recent investments will contribute to rapid growth in Belfair. In addition to the County's grant to extend the sewer system, a new freight corridor, or "bypass," is planned. We're refreshing the 2004 Belfair Plan and creating a Planned Action Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and ordinance to guide growth that reflects the community's vision.

The DEIS outlines alternatives for the future of Belfair's urban growth area (UGA), as well as potential benefits, such as protecting environmentally sensitive areas and addressing traffic congestion. The "No Action" alternative reflects current growth targets, Alternative 2 is similar to the existing development capacity in the UGA, and Alternative 3 reflects a higher growth scenario that would add residential, mixed use, and industrial park development to the UGA. The DEIS also outlines mitigation measures that would apply to future planned action development.
