FUNCTION

Under RCW 17.10.020, noxious weed control boards are created in every county in Washington. County weed boards consist of five voting members, appointed by the county legislative authority to represent five non-overlapping areas of the county.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Applicants **must** reside in district for which they apply and should be engaged in primary production of agricultural products, such as livestock; crops; shellfish; or Christmas trees.
- Ability to commit to a minimum of four meetings per year for a **four-year term**.
