Transportation Improvement Program – Citizens Advisory Panel

The Transportation Improvement Program Citizens Advisory Panel (TIP-CAP) is comprised of Mason County residents interested in the quality of Mason County roads and the service they provide. The TIP-CAP reviews and analyzes Mason County's transportation needs and presents their proposed transportation improvement program to the Board of Mason County Commissioners. The Board of Mason County Commissioners will use the transportation improvement plan developed by the TIP-CAP to plan road construction and other transportation projects for the next six years.

TIP-CAP is requesting information about Mason County Roads from the residents who drive our roads, to assist them in understanding what opinions Mason County residents have about our county road system. Information will be collected using survey forms which are available as a **salmon-colored insert** in the Shelton-Mason County Journal, at the Timberland Regional libraries in Hoodspoint, Belfair and Shelton, and from TIP-CAP members.
