Mason County Parks and Trails Department and the Capitol Land Trust would like to inform the public that the Mason County Parks and Trails Department and the Capitol Land Trust will be conducting a public workshop on **Thursday, April 3rd, starting at 6:30 p.m.** The purpose of the workshop is to invite the public to attend and provide additional comments from the first public workshop that was held during July of 2007.
