RE: Solid Waste Schedule Changes

Due to revenue shortfall and changes in the economic climate, the Utilities and Waste Management Department will be reducing the hours of service at our solid waste transfer stations.

Beginning on October 1, 2009, all four of our facilities will be open fewer days.

The transfer station in Shelton will be open only Tuesday through Saturday from 8-4, and will be closed on Sundays and Mondays.

The drop box in Belfair will also be open Tuesday through Saturday from 9-4, and will be closed on Sundays and Mondays.

The drop box in Hoodspout will be open on Fridays and Saturdays from 9-4 only.

The drop box in Union will be open on Sundays and Mondays from 9-4 only.

All sites will continue to accept recycling, including glass bottles and jars.

In addition, the recycling sites on Johns Prairie, the Pickering Park and Ride and the Matlock store will be closing this month as well.
