The Mason County Historic Preservation Commission is pleased to announce that proposals are being accepted from qualified candidates to conduct a Historic Maritime Resources Survey and Inventory.

Mason County recently received a grant from Washington State Department of Archeology and Historic Preservation to assist in the research and documentation of maritime related historic buildings, structures, objects and sites primarily associated with water transportation routes related to the movement of passengers, agricultural and forest products, mail and general cargo within the confines of Mason County waterways from the pre contact era to circa 1967.

Mason County has over 217 miles of marine shoreline and a rich maritime history filled with a colorful and important link to the development and the collective story the county. The survey project was developed to identify and document those resources before they disappear. The current phase of the project will be focusing on the North Bay area of the county and will include opportunities for public input and education.
