Hamma Hamma Cabin is located on the eastside of the Olympic Peninsula (near Hood Canal) in Washington State. Travel approximately 14 miles north of Hoodsport on US Highway 101 to Hamma Hamma Recreation Area, turn west onto the Hamma Hamma River Road, Forest Service Road (FSR) 25. Drive 6 miles to the entrance road on the right. 300 feet up the road is a locked gate. The cabin is around the corner, 300 feet beyond the gate.

The Mason County Historic Preservation Commission works to foster civic and neighborhood pride in the beauty and accomplishments of the past, a sense of identity based on the Mason County history and to raise community awareness of Mason County history and historic resources. The Mason County Historic Preservation meetings are open to the public.
