

RESOLUTION NO. 290

ORDER GRANTING SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGETS

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on December 19, 1972, declaring that unforeseen expenditures had arisen for which supplementary budgets were necessary for 1972 in the following departments; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following supplementary budgets will be required to meet them:

County Jail -----	2,000.00
County Fair -----	900.00
Registration -----	950.00
County Sheriff -----	4,700.00
Emergency Employment Act -----	6,300.00
Board of Equalization -----	4,200.00
Elections -----	<u>4,000.00</u>
TOTAL -----	\$30,050.00

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said **Supplemental** Budgets be held at 11:15 A. M., Tuesday, December 26, 1972, at a regular session of the Board, at the Courthouse at Shelton, Washington, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of said supplements;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Supplemental Budgets in amount \$30,050.00 must be approved, and the same is **HEREBY AUTHORIZED** to provide for the above stated expenditures, according to the laws governing supplemental budgets.
