

RESOLUTION NO. 291

ORDER GRANTING MISCELLANEOUS BUDGET EXTENSIONS

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on December 19, 1972, declaring that unforeseen expenditures had arisen for which Budget Extensions are necessary for 1972 in the following departments; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following extensions will be required to meet them:

County Fair -----	\$2,000.00
Board of Equalization -----	4,300.00
Elections -----	<u>5,000.00</u>
TOTAL -----	\$11,300.00

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget Extensions be held at 11:15 A. M., Tuesday, December 26, 1972, at a regular session of the Board, at the Courthouse at Shelton, Washington, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of said Budget Extensions;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Budget Extensions in amount \$11,300.00 must be provided, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED, to provide for the above stated expenditures, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
