

RESOLUTION NO. 300
ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on February 5, 1973, declaring that unforeseen expenditures had arisen for which Budget Extension is necessary for 1972 in the following department; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditure is necessary, and the following extension will be required to meet it:

County Sheriff - \$3,238.65 plus tax - Purchase and installation of Video Equipment - reimbursable by the ~~State Law & Justice Planning Department.~~ *Washington State Traffic Safety Commission.*

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget Extension be held at 11:00 A. M., Tuesday, February 20, 1973, at a regular session of the Board, at the Courthouse at Shelton, Washington, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of said Budget Extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Budget Extension in amount \$3,238.65 plus tax must be provided, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED, to provide for the above stated expenditure, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
