MASON COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 321

AN ORDINANCE implementing the Survey Recording Act (Chapter 50, Laws of 1973) and assisting in preserving evidence of land surveys by establishing fees for recording a public record, as prescribed by the Act.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MASON COUNTY, WASHINGTON:

SECTION 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. The purpose of this Ordinance is to implement the Survey Recording Act (Chapter 50, Laws of 1973) and to assist in preserving evidence of land surveys by establishing fees for recording a public record as prescribed by the Act.

SECTION 2. RECORD OF SURVEY. The record of land surveys shall be eighteen (18) inches by twenty-four (24) inches and filed according to the following fee schedule:

SECTION 3. <u>COPIES</u>. Copies of the record of survey shall be provided on request according to the following fee schedule:

A. Basic Fee -- first page \$5.00

B. Each Additional Page 3.00

SECTION 4. RECORD OF MONUMENT. The Record of Monument shall be filed without charge on the standard form prescribed by the Department of Natural Resources, Bureau of Surveys and Maps.

SECTION 5. <u>COPIES</u>. Copies of the Record of Monument shall be provided on request according to the following fee schedule:
