

RESOLUTION NO. 323

WHEREAS, L. J. Rossmailer retired on June 1, 1973 and desires payment in full for time worked plus accumulated fringe benefits, and

WHEREAS, the Mason County Road employees covered by Union Agreement are at present working under the 1972 Agreement because final agreement has not been ratified for 1973, and

WHEREAS, the wage increase for hourly-rated Mason County Road employees has been generally agreed between the County and the Union to be substantially equivalent to Twenty-five Cents (25¢) per hour, and

WHEREAS, it is agreed between the County and L. J. Rossmailer that an amount equal to Twenty-five Cents (25¢) per hour for all hours worked by him and payable to him to date since January 1, 1973 added to his regular payroll check for May 1973 plus accumulated fringe benefits pay which is due and payable will constitute full and complete payment to Mr. Rossmailer, and

WHEREAS, no further payment will be due or will ever be claimed by Mr. Rossmailer regardless of the nature of any Union Agreement which may be hereafter ratified by the County and its Union employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that L. J. Rossmailer be issued final payroll check in a total amount equal to all unpaid hours worked to June 1, 1973 including accumulated payable fringe benefits at the 1972 wage rate for this classification plus an additional amount equal to Twenty-five Cents (25¢) per hour for all hours payable since January 1, 1973.
