

RESOLUTION NO. 530

WHEREAS, the speed limits on County roads in Mason County, Washington, were fixed by Resolution adopted on January 9, 1956 as 35 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962 said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all County roads, unless otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, existing conditions on the Belfair Park - Tahuya Road (new construction) warrant speed limit of 35 miles per hour on a portion of the road;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that that portion of the Belfair Park - Tahuya Road be posted at 35 miles per hour effective upon opening of said road from Mile Post 0.95 (approximately) or Engineer's Station 50+00 (approximately) to Mile Post 0 or Engineer's Station 0+0, south-bound lane only, and the County Engineer is directed to erect the necessary 35 mile per hour signs on said road in conformity herewith.
