

RESOLUTION NO. 333

WHEREAS, there are on Mason County roads in two locations (the 1973 FAS Project County Road #9750 and on the 1971 Project on County Road #5767) embankment slopes totalling in area approximately five acres which are critically in need of immediate erosion protection, and

WHEREAS, a new material-technique combination for the solution of this type of problem has been proven by several recent large and small applications by the Washington State Highway Department, and

WHEREAS, there is only one source of material and there is not a general availability of qualified applicators, and

WHEREAS, the applicator, Western Landscaping, Inc. and the material manufacturer, The 3M Company, Inc. have jointly offered to provide such slope protection as a "model", or demonstration, project at a cost approximating 80% of the cost for identical work paid by the Washington State Highway Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Engineer be authorized to proceed with the application to these previously described areas in accordance with the proposal submitted by Western Landscaping, Inc. by their letter dated June 28, 1973, copy of which is appended hereto.
