

RESOLUTION NO. 342  
ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on July 31, 1973, declaring that an unforeseen emergency had arisen for which there is insufficient budget in the Mason County Jail Budget for 1973; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

County Jail -- Salaries & Wages (521-60-11) -----	\$9,555.00
Personal Benefits (521-60-13) -----	1,560.00
Food (521-60-22) -----	2,700.00
Photo Equipment (521-60-64-13) -----	<u>2,693.00</u>
Total -----	\$16,508.00

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:00 A. M., Monday, August 13, 1973, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount \$16,508.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditures, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
