

RESOLUTION NO. 355

ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on October 15, 1973, declaring that an unforeseen expense had arisen for which there is insufficient budget in the Mason County Election Fund; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

\$31,473.00 to cover the Punch Card Voting System
(Above amount currently budgeted in the Federal Shared Revenue Fund)

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget Extension be held at 1:45 P. M., Monday, October 29, 1973, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount \$31,473.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Federal Shared Revenue Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditures, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
