

RESOLUTION NO. 357

WHEREAS, littoral erosion on a portion of the south bank of the Dewatto estuary, especially in recent weeks, has dangerously decreased the effective width of County Road #7608 in many locations between approximate M. P. 4.20 and M. P. 4.45, and

WHEREAS, a continuation of this action to the complete destruction of the road seems inevitable if unchecked, and

WHEREAS, immediate revetment of the bank above mean high water and restoration of the road is necessary in the public interest, and

WHEREAS, the necessary earth and rock revetment above mean high water being in effect maintenance work restorative in character will constitute a minor action resulting in NO significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the work at once.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no permit is required under the Shorelines Management Act.
