

RESOLUTION NO. 368

ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on December 5, 1973, declaring that unforeseen expenses had arisen for which there is insufficient budget in the Mason County Superior Court Budget for 1973; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sums will be required to meet them:
