

RESOLUTION NO. 476

BUDGET EXTENSION - SHERIFF

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on January 21, 1975, declaring there was insufficient budget in the Sheriff's 1975 budget to cover a Law & Justice Planning Grant in amount \$4716.00 plus \$524.00 in County matching funds received for the purchase of four 4-channell portable radio units (two for the County and two for the City) to update the joint communication system; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the expenditure of these funds for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget extension be held at 11:30 A. M., Monday, February 3, 1975, at a regular session of the Board, at which time land place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Budget extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount \$5,240.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund where the grant was deposited, and is to be used for this purpose, in accordance with the laws governing budget extensions.
