

RESOLUTION NO. 486

BUDGET EXTENSION - DISTRICT COURT

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on February 25, 1975, declaring there were insufficient funds in the District Court's 1975 budget to cover "extra help" in amount \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the expenditure of these funds for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said budget extension be held at 2:15 P. M., Monday, March 10, 1975, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the budget extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above emergency budget extension in amount \$250.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund for this purpose.
