WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on April 1, 1975, declaring there were insufficient funds in the Assessor's 1975 budget to cover L-800 Bookkeeping Machine, Modification of present program, Purchase of 2 additional Cassettes, and Purchase of 1 Memory Unit, in the amount \$11,024.10, and




WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the expenditure of these funds for this purpose; and
