RESOLUTION NO. 499
ORDER OF VACATION
ROAD VAC. FILE NO. 92

IN THE MATTER OF THE VACATION OF: That portion of the Old Wivell Road
No. 1043, described as follows:

"A portion of the Old Wivell Road, County Road No. 1043, which was rendered unused by relocation, located in Section 3, Township 19 North, Range 4 West, W.M. More specifically described as : Beginning at a point at the westerly end of the old Rock Creek Bridge and running northeasterly in direction to the southerly right-of-way line of the Cloquallum Road, County Road No. 1000.

FIRST: That according to RCW 36.87, the Board of County Commissioners did, on March 17th, 1975, declare their unanimous intention to abandon the above described portion of County Road by Resolution.

SECOND: That a Hearing was set for 11:00 A.M., Monday, April 14, 1975, Notice of which was duly published and posted on the ground.

THIRD: That at said Hearing on April 14, 1975, the County Engineer presented a written report recommending the abandonment of the above described portion of County Road No. 1043.

FOURTH: At said Hearing no one appeared to object to the Vacation of said right-of-way and its return to the adjacent property owners, and the Clerk was unanimously directed to draw up an Order of Vacation for the closure of said portion of Old Wivell Road No. 1043.

IT IS HEREBY UNANIMOUSLY ORDERED BY THE BOARD IN SESSION that said portion of Old Wivell Road No. 1043, being more fully described above,

BE, AND HEREBY IS, VACATED, according to the provisions of the law heretofore cited and that said Vacated right-of-way revert to the adjoining property owners and be returned to the Tax Rolls.
