

RESOLUTION NO. 501

BUDGET EXTENSION - COUNTY CLERK

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on April 14, 1975, declaring there were insufficient funds in the County Clerk's 1975 budget to cover "repayment of bond paid on erroneous Court Order" in amount \$1,000.00; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the expenditures of these funds for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said emergency budget extension be held at 2:30 P. M., Monday, April 28, 1975, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the emergency budget extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above emergency budget extension in amount \$1,000.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund for this purpose.
