WHEREAS, 1976 is the Bicentennial Anniversary of the founding of our Country as a free and independent Nation; and

WHEREAS. Mason County being desirous of participating in the National Celebration, a Bicentennial Committee has been named to work out the particulars of the Celebration in Mason County, which will need funds to carry out their obligations and objectives; and

WHEREAS, a public Hearing was held at 11:30 A. M., Monday, May 19, 1975 in the office of the County Commissioners to consider establishing a budget for such purpose in amount $\$ 11,500.00$; and

WHEREAS, at the time of Hearing, a revised proposed Budget was presented, changing the request from $\$ 11,500.00$ to $\$ 10,600.00$ and no objections were received:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the revised budget in amount $\$ 10,600.00$ be approved (as attached), and the Treasurer be hereby directed to establish a "Bicentennial Fund" into which all proceeds and monies will be deposited.
