

RESOLUTION NO. 506

WHEREAS, 1976 is the Bicentennial Anniversary of the founding of our Country as a free and independent Nation; and

WHEREAS, Mason County being desirous of participating in the National Celebration, a Bicentennial Committee has been named to work out the particulars of the Celebration in Mason County, which will need funds to carry out their obligations and objectives; and

WHEREAS, a public Hearing was held at 11:30 A. M., Monday, May 19, 1975 in the Office of the County Commissioners to consider establishing a budget for such purpose in amount \$11,500.00; and

WHEREAS, at the time of Hearing, a revised proposed Budget was presented, changing the request from \$11,500.00 to \$10,600.00 and no objections were received;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the revised budget in amount \$10,600.00 be approved (as attached), and the Treasurer be hereby directed to establish a "Bicentennial Fund", into which all proceeds and monies will be deposited.
