

RESOLUTION NO. 507
EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on May 20, 1975, declaring there was insufficient budget in the Mason County Department of Public Works to cover unanticipated expenditures; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the expenditures; and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said emergency budget extension be held at 11:30 A. M., Monday, June 2, 1975, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the emergency budget extension as follows:

EXPENDITURES:

Landfill	\$15,500.00	
Transfer Stations	46,500.00	
Administration	<u>5,000.00</u>	\$67,000.00

REVENUE:

State Grant	\$59,000.00	
Landfill Fees	<u>8,000.00</u>	\$67,000.00

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above emergency budget extension in amount \$67,000.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED for the above purpose.
