

RESOLUTION NO. 512

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on May 26, 1975, declaring there was insufficient budget in the District Court's 1975 Budget to cover a Law & Justice Planning Grant in amount \$10,761.00 plus \$567.00 in County matching funds, to be used for salary and personal benefits for a District Court Probation Officer for period running from June 1, 1975 through May 31, 1976; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the expenditure; and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said emergency budget extension be held at 2:30 P. M., Monday, June 9, 1975, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the emergency budget extension as follows:

June 1, 1975 through December 31, 1975:	
Salary (\$800.00 per month)	\$5600.00
Personal Benefits	<u>1008.00</u>
Total 1975 appropriation:	\$6608.00

(The remaining \$4720.00 covering January 1, 1976 through May 31, 1976 will be provided for in the 1976 District Court Budget.)

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above emergency budget extension in amount \$6,608.00 must be allowed, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED for the above purpose.
