

RESOLUTION NO. 513

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on May 26, 1975, declaring there was insufficient budget in the following Current Expense Budgets to cover the buy-out of four L-5000 Burroughs Bookkeeping Machines being leased through Funding Systems Leasing Corporation in amount \$48,773.96, which was authorized by the Board of County Commissioners on January 13, 1975, and was to have been charged to Cumulative Reserve Fund No. 2; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the expenditures charged to the following Current Expense Budgets:

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said emergency budget extensions be held at 3:00 P. M., Monday, June 9, 1975, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the emergency budget extensions;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above emergency budget extensions in amount \$48,773.96 must be appropriated, and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to transfer said sum from Cumulative Reserve No. 2 Fund to Current Expense for this purpose.
