

RESOLUTION NO. 517  
EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION  
MISCELLANEOUS CURRENT EXPENSE BUDGET

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on June 16, 1975, declaring there was insufficient budget in the Mason County Miscellaneous Current Expense Budget to cover unanticipated expenditures; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the expenditures; and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said emergency budget extension be held at 11:00 A.M., Tuesday, July 1, 1975, at the regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the emergency budget extension as follows:

An amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 to cover additional insurance premium charges

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above emergency budget extension in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED for the above purpose.
