

RESOLUTION NO. 521

WHEREAS, Chapter 263, Laws of 1975 First Extraordinary Session did grant a pay raise for Superior Court Judges, raising their annual salaries from \$28,500.00 to \$34,250.00; and

WHEREAS, Mason County and Thurston County, as a Judicial District, has four Superior Court Judges which serve Mason County; and

WHEREAS, the 1975 Superior Court Budget will therefore be insufficient to cover the increase;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that a nondebatable emergency is hereby declared to exist for the salary increase for the remainder of 1975, and it is HEREBY ORDERED that the increase of \$1,446.24 be allowed for the remainder of the 1975 calendar year, to cover the unanticipated expenditure.
