

RESOLUTION NO. 527

WHEREAS, the updated Six-Year Road Program for Construction has been submitted by the Engineer as required by RCW 36.81.121, and

WHEREAS, the Board has been provided with and has considered the currently updated Priority Array for County Arterials in accordance with WAC 136-14-010 through -060, and has duly considered said Priority Array, and

WHEREAS, the funds foreseeable under present conditions as to become available for construction are drastically limited for 1976 and non-existent in 1978 and thereafter, and,

WHEREAS, meaningful programming for construction in accordance with the Priority Array becomes impossible, and

WHEREAS, urgently needed surface improvements to reduce maintenance costs and to prevent possible loss of surfacing, and spot improvements to improve safety remain of prime importance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Six-Year Road Program appended hereto be and is hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon completion of further priority and feasibility studies this program may be amended at a later date to include "Off-System" projects utilizing so-designated Federal funds.
