RESOLUTION NO. 529 EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION MASON COUNTY WEED CONTROL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on July 28, 1975, declaring there was insufficient budget in the Mason County Weed Control District Budget to cover the County's one-third share of the "Tansy Ragwort Pilot Program For 1975"; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the expenditure; and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said emergency budget extension be held at 11:00 A. M., Monday, August 11, 1975, at the regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the emergency budget extension as follows:

\$2800.00 to cover County's one-third share of Pilot Program for 1975, with the remaining two-thirds of the cost to be borne equally by the State Department of Agriculture and the landowner.

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above emergency budget extension in amount \$2800.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED for the above purpose.
