

RESOLUTION NO. 531
ESTABLISHMENT OF EMERGENCY BUDGET
RUSTLEWOOD SEWAGE AND WATER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on August 4, 1975, declaring the necessity to create a new budget item, to be known as Rustlewood Sewage and Water System, for the expenses incurred in the remainder of 1975; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the expenditures; and
