

RESOLUTION NO. 540  
EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION  
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on August 25, 1975, declaring there were insufficient funds in the 1975 Mason County Department of Public Works Budget to cover expenditures for the remainder of the calendar year; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for those expenditures; and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 3:00 P. M., Monday, September 8, 1975, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension as follows:

\$65,000.00 for operating expenses for the remainder of the 1975 calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Emergency Budget Extension in amount \$65,000.00 must be appropriated, and the County Treasurer is HEREBY DIRECTED to transfer said sum from the Cumulative Reserve No. 2 Fund, to the Department of Public Works Fund for the above purpose, at such time as requested by that Department.
