

RESOLUTION NO. 549

EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION  
SHERIFF

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on October 20th, 1975, declaring there were insufficient funds in the 1975 Mason County Sheriff's Budget to cover expenditures for the remainder of the calendar year; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for those expenditures; and,

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:00 A.M., Monday, November 3, 1975, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension as follows:

"\$7,500.00 for Vehicle Maintenance for the remainder of the calendar year"

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Emergency Budget Extension in amount \$7,500.00 must be appropriated, and the County Treasurer is HEREBY DIRECTED to transfer said sum from the Cumulative Reserve No. 2 Fund to the Mason County Sheriff Budget for the above purpose, at such time as requested by that Department.
