

RESOLUTION NO. 561-A

WHEREAS, the final Hearing on the adoption of the Mason County Budgets for 1976 was held on December 1, 1975 and finalization was held over to December 5, 1975 at which time budgets for 1976 for the Current Expense Fund, the Road Department, Department of Public Works and other budgets were finally adopted; and

WHEREAS, at the time of adoption, negotiations for salaries with the unionized County employees were still being carried on, and no salary figures were available for adoption at that time; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the Current Expense - or nonunionized employees of the County - receive the same salary consideration as the unionized employees of the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that the salary portions of all County budgets for 1976 be left open until all Union negotiations have ended; and

FURTHER, at such time as the Union Contracts are approved, that both the unionized and nonunionized employees of Mason County be given the same percentage increase in salaries, and that such increase be made retroactive to January 1, 1976.
