

RESOLUTION NO. 567

EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on December 17, 1975, declaring there were insufficient funds in the 1975 budgets to cover expenditures for the remainder of the calendar year as set out below; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for those expenditures; and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extensions be held at 11:00 A. M., Monday, December 29, 1975, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extensions as follows:

General Administration - Emergency Roof Repair ---	\$5,500.00
Superior Court - Court Reporters & Court Appointed Attorney Salaries -----	14,000.00
Juvenile Office - Other Services & Charges -----	937.19
Detention -----	1,000.00
Prosecutor - Maintenance & Operation -----	1,000.00
TOTAL -----	\$22,437.19

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Emergency Budget Extensions in amount \$22,437.19 must be appropriated, and the County Treasurer is HEREBY DIRECTED to transfer said sum from the General Current Expense Fund for the above purposes.
