

RESOLUTION NO. 583

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 538 dated September 8, 1975 the Board established a revised table of charges for solid waste received and handled at the Mason County Solid Waste Disposal Landfill and received at three outlying collection stations, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with existing informal agreements Resolution No. 538 made no change in the rates to be charged for bulk waste contributed by contract haulers and no change in the rates to be charged for the disposal of sludge from sewerage facilities, and

WHEREAS, these specific rates of charge are not sufficient to defray the proportionate cost of landfill operation and are not consistent with like charges for other materials and items set forth in the schedule of charges.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that in order to bring all charges at the landfill in conformity insofar as possible, the schedule of Charges to be Collected be amended effective March 1, 1976 to read as follows:
