

RESOLUTION NO. 589

NONDEBATABLE EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION
FORECLOSURE SURPLUS

WHEREAS, on December 4, 1970, the Mason County Treasurer held a tax foreclosure sale on the following property:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and N $\frac{1}{2}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, Township 22 North, Range 1 West, W.M., in Mason County, Washington; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 84.64.080, the County Treasurer did deposit into the Current Expense Fund the sum of \$5,620.19, which represented the foreclosure surplus, three years after said sale; and

WHEREAS, he has now received an "Application For Foreclosure Surplus" from Leonard Marshall and Mary Janet Morgan, heirs of the property owner at the time of the tax foreclosure sale;

THEREFORE, BY ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, and upon advice of the County Prosecuting Attorney, the County Treasurer is hereby directed to pay to the applicants the sum of \$5,620.19, which represents the foreclosure surplus received on said tax foreclosure sale; and

WHEREAS, this amount and purpose is not included in the current budget, and a Nondebatabable Emergency is hereby declared to exist for the above amount, and an interest bearing warrant will be issued for the above amount.
