FINAL DECLARATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

Description of Proposal: Relocate County Road #9750 M.P. 1.76 to M.P. 3.40 on right-of-way to be acquired through State Trust Lands by clearing, grading, drainage and surfacing a 34-ft. roadway to County Arterial Standards.

Proponent: Mason County Road Department.

Location of Proposal: M.P. 1.76 to M.P. 3.40, County Road #9750, Sections 33 & 34, Township 23 North, Range 2 West, W.M.

Lead Agency: Mason County.
