

RESOLUTION NO. 599

NON-DEBATABLE EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSIONS
SALARIES & BENEFITS
1976

WHEREAS, the undersigned did, on December 5, 1975, adopt Resolution No. 561-A, stating that at such time as the Union Contracts were approved, that both the unionized and non-unionized employees of Mason County would be given the same percentage increase in salaries, and that such increase would be made retroactive to January 1, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the Union Contracts were settled with an additional 3% increase in salaries;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the following budget extensions, covering the additional 3% salary increase for the non-union County employees salaries:

FURTHER, that the above budgets be extended in the above amount, totaling \$31,748.88.
