

RESOLUTION NO. 612

ESTABLISHMENT OF BICENTENNIAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, 1976 is the Bicentennial Anniversary of the founding of our Country as a free and independent Nation; and

WHEREAS, Mason County being desirous of participating in the National Celebration, a Bicentennial Committee has been named to work out the particulars of the Celebration in Mason County, which will need funds to carry out their obligations and objectives; and

WHEREAS, a public Hearing was held at 11:30 A.M., Monday May 10th, 1976 in the office of the County Commissioners to consider establishing a budget for such purpose in amount \$15,000.00; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made in the amount \$15,000.00 as a line item in the Miscellaneous Current Expense Budget to be used for the Logging Museum and other expenses incurred;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the budget in the amount \$15,000.00 be approved and the Treasurer be hereby directed to establish a "Bicentennial Fund", into which all proceeds and monies will be deposited.
