

RESOLUTION NO. 614

EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION
"Convention Center"

BUILDING TO BE KNOWN AS "Olympic Hall"

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on April 27th, 1976, declaring that revenue from a two percent hotel and motel sales tax will be forthcoming for the maintenance of the "Convention Center building at the Mason County Fair, the County Commissioners Budget must be extended in the estimated amount of \$7,000.00, to be set out as follows:

Receipts from 2% sales tax	\$7,000.00
Expenditures: Insurance	2,664.00
Maintenance	2,000.00
Capital Expenditures	<u>2,336.00</u>
TOTAL	\$7,000.00

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for those expenditures and revenue; and,

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:15 A.M., Monday, May 10, 1976, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgement of the Board the above Emergency Budget Extension in amount \$7,000.00 be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED for the above purpose.
