resolution no. 6/7

WHEREAS, the Personnel Policy of the Mason County Road Department, adopted December 26, 1973 and amended January 1, 1974, is in need of updating because of changed conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following changes be made:

Section II, paragraph 6d: New.

Time clocks shall be used as hereinafter prescribed by all hourly employees of the County Road Department:

- 1. Each employee shall punch his time card upon arrival at his respective reporting station and again upon leaving the job at the end of the work day.
- 2. No employee shall punch in or out for a fellow employee.
 - 3. If for any reason an employee does report for or leave from work at a different location then normal, the Road Superintendent will write in the starting and/or quitting time and will submit to the County Engineer a written reason for the deviation from the normal. This function will be performed by the Road Supervisor at Belfair and Matlock and the Superintendent will approve the reason.
 - 4. Any employee apprehended punching a time card other than his own will be subject to the following disciplinary actions:

1st offense - 1 day suspension without pay.
2nd offense - 3 days suspension without pay.
3rd offense - Dismissal with cause.

Section II, paragraph 7ê: Amend first sentence. Change thirty (30) to forty five (45).

Section II, paragraph 8b: Amend. Change ninety (90) to one hundred twenty (120).

Section II, paragraph 13(7): Columbus Day - Delete.

Section II, paragraph 13(8): Change First Monday in October to November 11.

Section II, paragraph 13(9): Delete.

Section II, paragraph 13(12): New. Day after Thanksgiving, November, Fourth Friday.

Section II, paragraph 13(13): Floating. Anytime, prior approval by Engineer.

Section II, paragraph 17: New.

If any portion of Section II is in conflict with County Ordinances, State or Federal Statute or the Union Agreement then the Statute, Ordinance or Union Agreement will take precedence.
