COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION No. 620

COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 819

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 5172 known locally as the Johns Prairie Road, and more specifically located in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 5, TS 20N, Range 3 W.W.M., M.P. 1.15 to M.P. 1.52, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 104A on the officially adopted county annual road program,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to reconstruct 0.37 mile. Principal quantities are:

1.0 Acre Clearing and Grubbing  
1700 C.Y. Common Excavation  
600 C.Y. Top Course  
4700 Sq. Yd. BST Class "A"  
270 Lin. Ft. 12" Culvert

and that said work is to be performed by (day labor) (~~contract~~) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

Engineering	\$ <u>1,700.00</u>
Right-of-Way	<u>2,079.00</u>
Road Construction	<u>13,190.00</u>
Bridge Construction	<u>\$16,969.00</u> ( <u>16,969.00</u> )

Engineer's Estimate in detail is on file in the office of the County Engineer.

The County Road Project herein described is HEREBY DECLARED to be a public necessity, and the County Road Engineer is HEREBY ORDERED AND AUTHORIZED to report and proceed thereon as by law, provided, and in accordance with WAC 136-18.
