

RESOLUTION NO. 621-A

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH COUNTY ROADS

PLAT OF LAKELAND VILLAGE NO. 6

WHEREAS, on Monday, June 7, 1976, in conformance with RCW 36.81.010, the Board of County Commissioners entered upon their Minutes a motion declaring their intention to establish "all roads dedicated to the public in the Plat of Lakeland Village No. 6" as County roads, all located in Mason County, Washington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed County roads are a public necessity, and that the County Engineer be directed to report thereon, and the Clerk of the Board shall fix a time and place for hearing the report as required by statute, and that the Prosecuting Attorney be requested to review and give approval to the steps herein ordered.
